___ 2 Boxes of Tissues

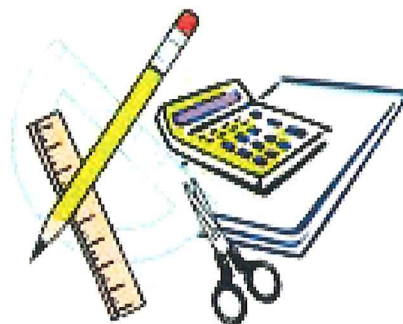
___ Colored Pencils (sharpened)
